

## **American Bowmen Club Meeting of December 9, 2009**

President Morgan Montgomery called the meeting to order at 7:03 pm.

### **Old Business:**

The minutes of the August meeting were read and approved.

Treasurer Jeff Fleischer being in absence, Ivan James read the treasurer's report. It was approved. We are basically down \$1800 from rent payments and plus a six pack of beer in interest.

The transfer of \$3500 to the money market account approved in August has not occurred.

Dale reported that the trail camera caught no one using broadheads and no trespassers. He will have a more extensive network of trail cams and spy satellites out next year.

### **New Business:**

There was a discussion of the robo-call program. Ken S. reported that calling out to 101 phone numbers cost \$4.85. A motion to continue the program, reimburse Ken for his initial \$10 and add \$60 to the robo-call account passed.

Ken has found a cheaper place for the pheasant hunt. It is \$10 per bird. We set Feb.13 as the hunt date and asked for 20-30 birds depending upon participation from club members.

The ABC banquet date was set as Feb. 6, a date mutually available for Bear Creek Archery and the club.

Targets—Our two elk targets have been vandalized by a bear but should be O.K. for next year, but maybe with shorter legs. A motion to buy a moose target was approved. Dale will get an order to Rockwell.

Officer nominations—Dale agreed to stand as V.P. and Jeff again as treasurer. Morgan reported that he is gonzo, goodbye, zap, outta-here as Prez., so we will have to get other nominations from the floor at the Jan. meeting. Thanks to him for his recurring service.

Shoot dates—April 11, May 16, June 13, June 20, July 11, Aug. 8 were established with work parties the day before.

Ivan was instructed to relay to the CBA the ABC concern that the CBA is putting nothing into the Joseph's Journey shoot. Last year no board members were in attendance and the only advertising was within the ABC list of shoots in the magazine. Ascertain if the CBA wants to continue to be involved or let it devolve into an ABC sponsored event.
