

American Bowmen Club Meeting of January 13, 2010

President Morgan Montgomery called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

Old Business:

The minutes of the December meeting were read and approved with a date correction.

Treasurer Jeff Fleischer reports that it is good that we did not transfer the \$3500 from checking to the money market account as approved in August as the money has been spent on rent (\$450 per month) and targets (~\$4700). Membership renewals are starting to come in to replenish.

Banquet--Doy reports that the plaques and engraving has been ordered for the trophies reported before Rockwell left for Mexico. Dale will contact Stover to get the tables as Hootie is suffering from some combination of a bad back and being in love.

Targets—Dale placed the order directly with RMSG and let them know that we didn't need the targets until April.

Pheasant hunt—Swanson will make up an announcement with map to be passed out at banquet.

Shoot dates—Joseph's Journey shoot added for June 27.

CBA participation in JJ shoot—Ivan requests more time getting a CBA response.

New Business:

Dale will get shoot flyer electronics to Mike M. for printing before banquet to be handed out there and Dale will get to pro shops.

Ken requested that we fund Kinkos to produce and mail flyers. He was given authority to request prices for this kind of service.

Work party incentive program—Baker moved and it was approved to maintain the program through 2010 at \$750 cash for first place and \$250 cash for second place as it was in 2009.

Dale brought up the request from Columbine to use our range for their shoots if need be this year. It was approved to enter into a joint venture with them on the shoots (if needed) so that our insurance would cover the event. We would work out some arrangement on sharing the revenue to cover target wear and tear and some presence of ABC members to supervise both the shoot and work parties.

Dale will also get an e-mail out to member reminding them of the Wednesday shoots and that we need to do a better job of showing up or Bear Creek Archery will not be able to justify staying open for us.

Elections:

With nothing more than a short campaign speech, Jeff was re-elected as treasurer. In the hotly contested race for Vice President, Mike Manning narrowly beat out Dale. As a consolation prize for losing the VP slot, Ivan nominated Dale for President and he squeezed by against no opposition. Despite much pleading and whimpering, Ivan was re-elected as secretary. Belchar, Baker and Swanson (sounds like a law firm or perhaps a double play trio, though not as famous as Tinkers to Evers to Chance) were re-elected as the Board of Directors to keep an eye and oversight on the club officers, none of whom have (recently) absconded with club funds.
